We are therefore committed to reducing our environmental impact and continually improving our environmental performance as an integral and fundamental part of our business strategy and operating methods.

Our policy is to:

- Wholly support and comply with or exceed the requirements of current environmental legislation and codes of practice.

- Operate and maintain company vehicles (where appropriate) with due regard to environmental issues as far as reasonably practicable and encourage the use of alternative means of transport and car sharing as appropriate.
- Apply the principles of continuous improvement in respect of air, water, noise and light pollution from our premises and reduce any impacts from our operations on the environment and local community eg all vehicles carry brushes and shovels to ensure broken glass hasn't been left on the highway, using the appropriate kits to address any oil leakage etc
- As far as possible, purchase products and services that do the least damage to the environment and encourage others to do the same.
- Assess the environmental impact of any new processes or products we intend to introduce in advance.
